Cochise County is designated as Hardiness Zone 8 by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). The recommended plants on this list are intended to provide regionally/ climatically-appropriate, water efficient, and attractive options for your Cochise County property.

Once established, many native and desert adapted plants can survive on rainfall along with occasional supplemental watering during extended dry periods. Even during dry periods, established succulents need very little water, and should not be watered unless they appear stressed.
