Who Can Vote in the Primary Election?

Any Cochise County registered voter may vote in the Primary Election.

However, Independents, Party Not Designated, No Party Preference or voters registered as “Other”, who vote an Early Ballot, will receive a 90-Day Notice from the Recorder’s Office. These voters **must** respond to the 90-Day Notice, returning it to the Recorder indicating which of the party ballots they wish to vote (i.e., of the parties which are recognized political parties at the Cochise County level (currently only Democrat or Republican).

If Independents (and other voters not registered with a Cochise County-recognized political party) vote at the Vote Centers (instead of voting an Early Ballot), they will need to make a choice at the Vote Center for which party ballot they would like to vote.
