The City of Douglas has announced the official candidates for the upcoming 2016 Primary Election set for Tuesday, March 8, 2016.

On September 9, 2015, Mayor and Council approved Resolution No. 15-1106, which authorizes the City Clerk to conduct the 2016 elections and all future municipal elections as mail ballot elections thus eliminating the traditional polling locations. Therefore, on Election Day beginning at 6:00 a.m. and ending at 7:00 p.m., City Hall located at 425 10th Street will serve as a “drop-off” location for ballots that are not returned by mail as they must be received by the Cochise County Recorder’s Office by 7:00 p.m. on March 8, 2016, in order to be counted. Additionally, replacement ballots will be issued, at City Hall on Election Day only, if the ballot is lost, spoiled, destroyed or not received. If a replacement ballot is required prior to Election Day, please contact the Cochise County Recorder’s office by telephone at (520) 432-8358 or in person at 1415 Melody Lane – Building B, Bisbee, AZ 85603.

If in the Primary Election, one candidate for Mayor or one candidate for Council Member does not receive a majority of the votes cast, the two candidates, with the highest number of votes will appear on the ballot of the General Election on May 17, 2016, excluding the names of write-in candidates.

The name of the write-in candidate you wish to vote for must be written in the space provided on the ballot and the oval left of the name must be filled out with black ink only.

If the Cochise County Recorder’s Office received your completed Arizona Voter Registration form on or before February 8, 2016, you will be eligible to vote at the City of Douglas Primary Election. Ballots will be mailed on Wednesday, February 10, 2016! However, if you have not registered, but wish to vote at future elections please register at the following locations: City Clerk’s Office, Cochise County Recorder’s Office, Library, Department of Motor Vehicles, United States Post Office, or online through the Secretary of State’s Office at www.azsos.gov.

In accordance to Arizona State Law, the required test of automatic equipment and programs to ascertain that the equipment and programs will correctly count the votes cast at the Primary Election on March 8, 2016, will be held on Tuesday, February 23, 2016, at 1:00 p.m. at the office of the Cochise County Elections Department, 1415 Melody Lane – Building A, Bisbee, AZ 85603. This test is open to the public.
