

GENERAL ELECTION, TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2014

BE SURE TO REGISTER TO VOTE FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION

Did you know that OCTOBER 6, 2014 is the last day to register to vote if you wish to vote in the November 4th General Election? Fortunately, it is easy to do! That means that your Registration Form must be dated and postmarked no later than October 6th or delivered to the County Recorder's Office by that date. You may also register online.

REQUIREMENTS TO REGISTER:

Be a United States citizen and provide proof of citizenship.

Be a resident of Arizona 29 days before the election and in the county listed on your registration

Be 18 years of age or more on or before the day of the next regular General Election.

You Cannot Register to Vote in Arizona if:

You have been convicted of a felony and have not yet had your civil rights restored.

You have been adjudicated incompetent.

HOW TO REGISTER:

There are several ways to register to vote:

You can register to vote at the Recorder's office, or pick up a form at any County Service Center. The Recorder's Office will mail you a registration form if

requested by calling 520-432-8358 or emailing voterreg@cochise.az.gov . You can also register online at www.cochise.az.gov by checking the box on the left for “Elections” and then the box “Register to Vote.”

You may also register to vote at the Motor Vehicle Department by checking the appropriate box when you go to get your Arizona Driver’s License. Or you can go directly to the Service Arizona website at www.servicearizona.com. Once there, check the box entitled “Voter Registration” and follow the instructions. You can also get to this website through the Secretary of State’s website at www.azsos.gov These websites are the best way to update your registration information.

REGISTRATION – THEN WHAT?

Once you register, your information will be verified by the Cochise County Recorder. After you are determined to be a qualified elector, you will be mailed a Voter Registration card.

If you would like to vote an early ballot, the last day that you can request one for the General Election is October 24th. If you wish to be placed on a Permanent Early Voting List to be able to vote by mail at all future elections, please contact the Recorder’s Office at 520-432-8358.

If you have moved to a new residence, changed your name or political party you must complete a new registration form at the Recorder’s Office or online.

Registering to vote is the first step in having your voice heard and participating in our democratic process.
