IN RE: ANNUAL DEPENDENCY TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Rule of Juvenile Procedure 40.1 defines the initial and ongoing annual training requirements for attorneys appointed to represent children in juvenile dependency cases. Further, it is the obligation of these attorneys to annually file an affidavit of compliance with the training requirements to the Juvenile Presiding Judge. The court has taken notice of a significant level of non-compliance with this requirement. This order offers clarification.

IT IS ORDERED:

Pursuant to the rule, attorneys are directed to annually file the affidavit of compliance with the Juvenile Presiding Judge. In addition, attorneys should submit a copy of this affidavit to:
