## Part-Time Detention Officer Program

The Cochise County Jail has established a part-time Detention Officer program. With your background in law enforcement/corrections, as our Detention Officer you will be overseeing and monitoring the activities of the inmates or detainees in living areas and recreation activities. You will be coordinating and monitoring inmate or detainee movements, conducting counts and providing emergency response as needed. In addition, you may be assigned to various posts including, but not limited to, the control room, health services, special housing, perimeter safety, transportation, booking, etc. After OJT, the part-time officer works up to 19.5 hours per week. The workdays and hours are selected by you. At orientation you will be given a password that will enable you to access the jail schedule for Bisbee, Sierra Vista and Willcox, you will be able to select available slots as reflected on the schedule. You can work as much as 19.5 hours a week or as little as 8 hours a month. You must work at least 8 hours a month to maintain your active status with Cochise County. . If selected for employment, part-time applicants must attend the Pre-Service orientation and then undergo 5 days of on-the-job training (not in a row, will work within your schedule).
