Food Vendors:

A current Cochise County Food Handlers Certificate is required for individuals who are in the booth with food or beverage items. Please call Cochise County Health Dept if you don't currently have a license. For more information please contact:

Health and safety inspections will be conducted prior to the start of the event and during the hours of operation. If any violation in handling food or beverages is observed, reported, or a safety hazard exists, vendors must correct the problem immediately or they will be closed down.

1. Gas and charcoal barbecue grills are authorized. Open fires are NOT. Electric grills or stoves are permitted as long as the vendor stays within the electrical limitations. You can bring your own generator. We will not maintain it or gas it. (20 AMPS of electrical power) (Maximum of 2000 watts)
2. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS: Vendors using any cooking equipment and/or electrical equipment must provide their own fire extinguisher at the space before operations are allowed. Vendors are responsible for meeting Hazardous Materials and EPA regulations and paying any fines that may incur from violations.
3. Water will be available on the grounds for food preparation purposes (with limited water connections). The Sheriff's Office will not provide water hoses, water coolers, or covered containers for water storage/ carrying purposes.
4. Food vendor concessions will be limited due to space available.
5. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY BE SOLD BY ANY VENDOR.
6. Only one vendor per type of food OR craft business (i.e. Shaved Ice, BBQ, Hamburgers & Hot Dogs, Kettle Corn, Direct Sales businesses, etc.) will be allowed to participate.
7. If two similar businesses request to participate, the first to complete this application and submit payment will secure their spot at the event.
8. Vendors must provide their own booth structure and ALL equipment needed to run their booth. They must be neat in appearance, and for everyone's safety, it is recommended that each canopy be staked down due to possible winds and/or rain. Surface for vendors is on hard packed grass.

SET UP AND BREAK DOWN FOR ALL VENDORS :

Set up will take place between 10:00 AM and 11:30 AM, with vendors being ready to begin selling at 11:30 AM. Breakdown will begin anytime after 4:00 PM. Vendors must be open for business between 11:30 AM and 4:00 PM on the event date.

Food & Craft Vendor Agreement:

The VENDOR APPLICANT agrees that the Cochise County Sheriff's Office assumes NO responsibility or liability for any defects or other conditions of the sites, whether the conditions are known or unknown to either party, and/or discoverable by either party.

The VENDOR APPLICANT has considered and evaluated the risks, dangers and possibility of injury resulting from the activities described in the vendor permit application and agrees that it knows and understands that foreseeable and unforeseeable injuries could occur from the activities described in the vendor permit application.

The VENDOR APPLICANT knowingly agrees to assume the risk for any and all defects, dangers and possibility of injury, whether these defects, dangers and possibility of injury are foreseeable by either party, or are know or unknown to either party.

The VENDOR APPLICANT shall indemnify and hold the Cochise County Sheriff's Office and its officers, agents and employees harmless and free any and all claims or suit including but not limited to personal injury and property damage. This indemnification and hold harmless includes, but is not limited to, the payment of all attorney fees, expenses, costs, judgments and other expenses which may be incurred by the Cochise County Sheriff's Office, its officers, agents or employees as a result of any and all such claims or suits.

By signing this agreement, vendor agrees to comply with all state and local laws and the rules and regulations of the 3rd Annual CCSO Charity Ride.
